

## **Timpi International Ltd Privacy Policy Updated version**

### Introduction

At Timpi International Ltd ("we," "us," or "our"), your privacy is a priority. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, and share your information when you use our search engine and related services (collectively, the "Service"). It also outlines your rights under applicable laws.

By accessing or using the Service, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with our policies, please refrain from using our Service.

### Information We Collect

We collect information in the following ways:

#### 1. When You Visit Our Website

- **IP Address:** We may store your IP address temporarily to detect malicious activity and determine a rough geographic location (country-level only).
- **Search Queries:** Search queries are stored along with location data but are not combined with user-identifiable information.

#### 2. While Your Session is Active (Not Stored)

- **Language Detection:** We detect your browser's language to provide localized services.
- **Web3 Wallet Detection:** If a Web3 wallet add-on is installed in your browser, we may detect its presence but do not store this information.

#### 3. When You Create a Profile

Profiles are stored initially on our servers and later transferred to decentralized guardian nodes for enhanced privacy and security. The information collected depends on your account type:

- **Web3 Users:**
  - Wallet address
  - Nickname
  - Email address (if voluntarily provided)
- **Web2 Users:**
  - Email address
  - Nickname

## How We Use Your Information

We use the information collected for the following purposes:

- To provide, maintain, and improve our Service.
- To personalize user experiences based on location or language preferences.
- To detect and prevent fraudulent or malicious activities.
- To comply with legal obligations.

## Data Sharing Practices

We share limited information with third parties as follows:

### Shared Data

- Ad Clicks: Information about who clicked an ad.
- Geolocation: Country-level location data.
- Search Queries: Shared in aggregate form without combining them with user-identifiable data.
- Keywords: Shared for ad targeting purposes.

## Restrictions on Sharing

- We do NOT match sessions across different visits.
- We do NOT allow retargeting by advertisers or third parties.
- No profile data (e.g., email address, nickname) will be shared unless required by law.

## Legal Compliance

We may disclose personal information if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g., court orders).

## Server Logs

Our servers automatically record information created by your use of our Service, which may include:

- Server log data
- Crash reports
- System activity
- Request dates and times
- Referring/exit pages

## Third-Party Service Providers

We may share general information with third-party vendors, service providers, and other partners who help us provide and improve our Service, such as companies that provide:

- Data analysis
- Payment processing

- Customer service
- Email delivery
- Hosting services
- Technical infrastructure
- Feedback tools

These service providers are authorized to use our general, non profiled user information only as necessary to provide services to us.

#### Legal Requirements

We may disclose your information if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g., a court or government agency).

#### Business Transfers

If Timpi International Ltd is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of its assets, your information may be transferred as part of that transaction.

#### Data Retention

We retain your information for as long as necessary to provide you with our Service and for other essential purposes such as complying with our legal obligations, resolving disputes, and enforcing our agreements.

The criteria used to determine our retention periods include:

- The length of time we have an ongoing relationship with you
- Whether there is a legal obligation to which we are subject
- Whether retention is advisable in light of our legal position (such as in regard to applicable statutes of limitations, litigation, or regulatory investigations)

#### Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to maintain the security of your personal information, including safeguards designed to protect against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage.

However, please understand that no method of electronic storage or transmission over the internet is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

#### Your Privacy Rights

Depending on your location, you may have certain rights regarding your personal information:

#### For All Users:

- Access your personal information
- Correct inaccurate personal information
- Request deletion of your personal information
- Object to the processing of your personal information
- Request restrictions on the processing of your personal information
- Data portability

#### For European Economic Area (EEA) Residents:

Additional rights under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), including the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

#### For California Residents:

Additional rights under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) and California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA), including the right to opt out of the sale of personal information.

#### Children's Privacy
